

Fall Training Conference 2009 Campfire Skit/Talent Showcase Audition Upload Instructions

Auditions will be submitted via YouTube video. Follow these simple instructions below to successfully submit your skit and/or act to the FTC youtube account. If you do not follow these instructions and do not post your audition video to the FTC YouTube account, your skit and/or act will not be included in the audition process.

First: Create An Account

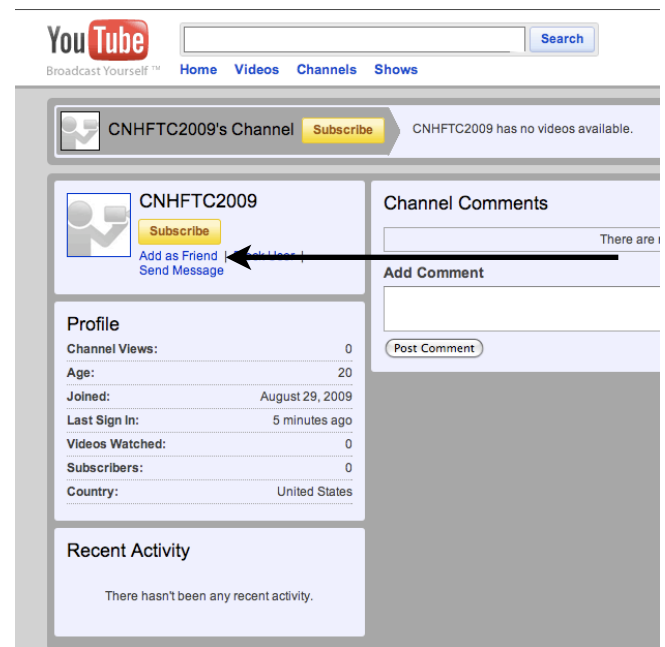
1. You will first need to create a **YouTube** account. Either create a new account by clicking “Sign Up” found on the top right corner of www.youtube.com , or you can use your/ a friend’s / club’s account.

Second: You must add CNHFTC2009 to your friends list

1. Go to <http://www.youtube.com/cnhftc2009>
2. On the upper left panel, you will find a link that says “Add as friend.” Click on this link and a request from you will be sent to me.
3. Wait it out a bit and I will approve of your request in no time! Once I approve, move on to the next step.

Third: Upload and send your video

1. Before uploading your video(s), be sure your campfire skit admission is at most 5-7 minutes and your talent showcase auditions as at most 2-3 minutes. This is just the skit and/or showcase performance itself. This does not include any introduction you might want to add at the start or end of the video.
2. To upload your videos, click on “Upload” on the upper right hand corner of the website.
3. This will take you to an uploading page. Click “Upload Video” to select and upload your video file(s). One you select your video, it will start uploading automatically and a a box of logistics will appear. Fill in the “TITLE” with the name of your school, and whether it is a campfire skit audition or a talent showcase audition (i.e, “UC Berkeley Campfire Skit Audition” or “PCC Talent Showcase Audition”).



4. After you have filled out your title, there is a portion on the “Video File Upload” page called “Privacy.” **IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT THAT YOU CLICK “Private (Viewable by you and up to 25 people).”** This way others will not be able to see the skits/talent auditions you uploaded.
5. After your video is finished uploading and you are done with the above steps, hover over your account name at the tope right hand of the website, then click “My Videos.” This will take you to the “Uploaded Videos” page.
6. The video you have just uploaded should be the first one on the list. For your video, click the

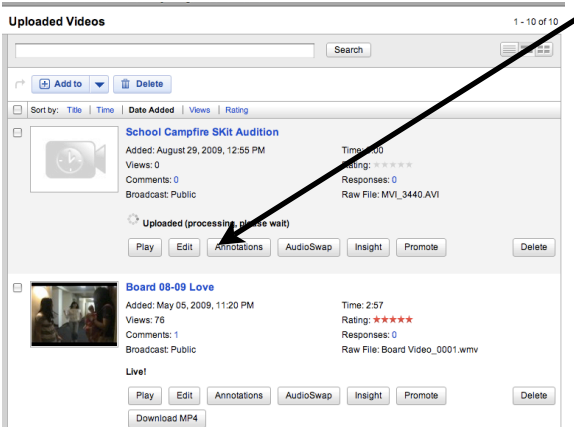

“Edit” button.

7. Once you are on the next page, scroll down to the box that says “Broadcasting and Sharing Options.” Under “Privacy,” check the box that says “Private share with YouTube friends.” A box will pop up underneath the checkmark. Click “Friends” and check the box next to the CNHFTC2009 user.

8. Click “Save Changes” located near the bottom of the page, and you are complete!



Videos are to be sent no later than 11:59 PM on **WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 21st, 2009**. Make sure you follow the guidelines on the Campfire Skit/Talent Showcase Application.
