The Kiwanis Cal Nev Ha Foundation annually awards scholarships to eligible Circle K District members. To be eligible to apply for a scholarship the applicant must be a dues paid member of a club in good standing with both Circle K International and the District, be enrolled in a college or university, and hold a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 on a 4.0 point scale (as evidenced by official transcript).

Scholarship awards are based on the merit of the member's involvement and contributions to Circle K, their campus and community. Awards typically range from \$750 - \$2,500. Additionally, the top scholarship recipient is presented with an additional \$500 award from Circle K International through the District's participation in the Circle K International matching scholarship program. No additional application is required for the matching program.

Please read all instructions carefully before you begin.

Instructions:

1. The application is divided into three sections but weighted differently
 - A. **Service Leadership Programs Service is 50% of your score.** *List* service done as a Circle K member, offices held, projects chaired, service projects organized, etc.
 - B. **Service to your School is 25% of your score.** *List* offices held (other than in Circle K) and participation in school organizations and projects but not as part of your Circle K activities.
 - C. **Service to your Community is 25% of your score.** *List* organizations and projects you were involved in through your church or religious institutions, other community service groups not affiliated with Kiwanis or an activity accomplished on your own. Do not include service to the community as part of your Circle K activities.

Duplication of activities in more than one section will not be considered by the judges. *Specifically* comment on your contribution to the project. Statements like "I organized a blood drive that collected a school record of over 5,000 pints of blood" carries more weight with the judges than, "I attended four conventions."

2. Use dates. *List* specific accomplishments, number of people served, awards received and recognition given.
3. The applicant's name must appear on the International dues forms for the current year.
4. ***This application must be typed and limited to this form only.*** It may be scanned *as is* into a word processor for easy completion. **NO ATTACHMENTS WILL BE CONSIDERED IN THE JUDGING.** ***The committee will not accept anything less than a 9-point font!***
5. Applications must be RECEIVED in the Kiwanis District Office by the indicated date above. Applications may be mailed to the Kiwanis District Office, Attn: Service Leadership Program Scholarships, 8360 Red Oak Street #201, Rancho Cucamonga, CA 91730. Applications received after the above date will NOT be considered by the judging committee.
6. A copy of your **official transcripts** should accompany this application. If it must be mailed separately, the applicant must assume all risk of loss, delay and/or disqualification if the transcripts cannot be matched to the application. No application will be considered without a copy of your official transcripts. **A minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 point scale is required.**
